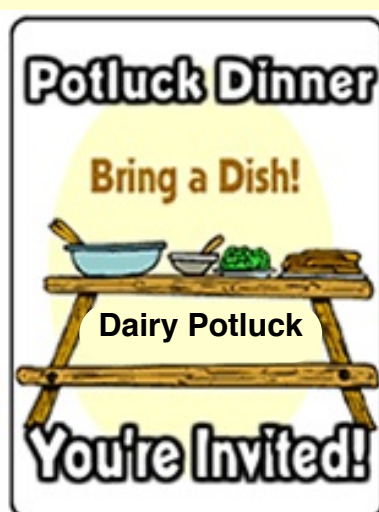

*From the Rabbi...*



I know it is hard to think of High Holy Days as we await the birth and renewal of spring, but for rabbis that is what we do. If you were with us Rosh Hashanah evening this past High Holy Days you had the opportunity to experience the beauty of a test version of **Mishkan HaNefesh**, the new Reform Movement Mahzor for High Holy Days. The Mahzor we currently use, Gates of Repentance, was published in 1978, almost forty years ago. There is a sense of comfort with the old and familiar. There is also a chance for further introspection on the Days of Awe with newer and more current readings. **Mishkan HaNefesh** continues that tradition of keeping the prayers that are special and meaningful to us. It also adds beautiful readings that stir the heart and inspire the mind.

**Mishkan HaNefesh** offers meaningful liturgy for both regular service attendees and those new to Jewish spirituality and practice. It inspires a multifaceted experience from feelings of awe to moments of solace, from the solitude of contemplation to the solidarity of song and worship. It embraces the rich liturgical voices of our Jewish past and the aspirations of our people today. It offers a range of theological possibilities for those who struggle with the aspect of God depicted in the High Holy Day liturgy.

In addition, **Mishkan HaNefesh** provides fully transliterated liturgy, as we have in Mishkan T'filah. This enables those who cannot read Hebrew to participate in the rhythmic and poetic sounds of the Hebrew prayers, helping to feel part of our worship community.

For all these reasons I hope you will consider helping us acquire this new High Holy Day prayer book to use at Temple Sholom. You have the opportunity to donate books to temple in honor of or in memory of someone special, or just because. A bookplate will be placed on the inside cover of the book. (And you get two for one since the Mahzor comes as a set of two books.) Each set costs \$36. Please fill out the form and mail it to the temple along with your check. It is important that you get your check in before the summer. We will need to make a decision in July whether we have enough books to use for the coming year.

Israeli poetry – Contemporary and 20<sup>th</sup>/21<sup>st</sup> century. Emphasis will be on content and style with a focus on critical analyses.

**Maimonides – Tuesdays 11:30 a.m.-12:45 p.m. ~ Teacher: Rabbi Michele Medwin**

**Start date: March 1**

Moses Ben Maimon, also known as Maimonides or Rambam, was a learned Jewish scholar and physician, whose teachings have been studied for centuries. *How should we describe God? What is so important about Monotheism? Why is the Torah important? If God created the Universe, why is there evil? What does Judaism teach about morals and ethics? How can we repent?* These are some of the issues that Maimonides struggled with in the 12<sup>th</sup> century that we also struggle with in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. We will learn about some of Maimonides' teachings and discuss their relevance to us in today's world.

**Kabbalah and Jewish Mysticism: Part II – Tues, 1:00 pm-2:15 pm ~ Teacher: Rabbi Michele Medwin**

**Start date: March 1**

Based on the book, "God is a Verb: Kabbalah and the Practice of Mystical Judaism" by Rabbi David Cooper, author of several books on Jewish meditation and Jewish mystical practice. *Who are we? Where did we come from? Where are we going? How do we get there?* These questions have fueled Kabbalists for nearly a millennium. Rabbi David A. Cooper is the first to bring this obscure and difficult tradition to a mainstream audience in a way that gently leads us to the heart of the subject, showing us how to transform profound teachings into a meaningful personal experience—and appreciate fully this great mystical process we know as God.. (Please purchase this book on your own. It is available through Amazon.com and Barnes and Noble.) This is a continuation of the first semester. There will be a brief review in the first class, so, you are welcome to join us for this course even if you did not take the previous one.

**Conversational Hebrew for Beginners -- Tuesdays, 2:30-3:45 p.m. ~ Teacher: Stephanie Phillips**

**Start date: March 1**

This course in modern Israeli Hebrew will emphasize speaking. Students will learn through hearing and repetition, with the help of recorded segments. Being able to pronounce words by reading Hebrew letters isn't absolutely necessary if a student is willing to use his or her own notation and memorize spoken words.
