From the rabbi:

## Modah Ani



Giving thanks is a strong Jewish tradition. From sacrifices in the wilderness and at the Temple in Jerusalem, to reciting prayers instead of sacrifices after the destruction of the Temple, we have always found ways to appreciate what God has given us.

Each morning, Jewish tradition invites us to offer a prayer of thanksgiving, *Modeh Ani*. It is the most important thing we can thank God for. As we wake up, we recite, “I thank you God for returning my soul to me.” In other words - thank God that I lived to see another day. The *Modeh Ani* prayer is in the singular. (Women say *Modah Ani*.) It invites us to ask, “What am **I** personally grateful for?”

There is also a prayer for thanksgiving in every worship service, *Modim anachnu lach*. **We** thank You, God, for our lives which are in Your hand, for our souls which are in Your care, for Your miracles that we experience every day... The *Modim* prayer is plural. What are **we** grateful for as a community?

It is said that every rabbi has three or four messages that are the basis of all their sermons and teachings. One of mine is, “No matter how bad things may seem, there is always something you can find to be grateful for.” By doing this, we can face each day with joy, rather than only sorrow. We find time at each Shabbat service, to reflect on the past week and recall what we are

thankful for. But once a week is not enough. If you don’t participate in daily worship, a good practice I suggest to my therapy clients, is to list at least three things you are grateful for each day.

As I reflect over the past seventeen years at Temple Sholom, I am grateful for the original search committee that believed in me and asked me to be your rabbi. I am grateful that Temple Sholom gave me a spiritual home in which I could share my love of Judaism. I am grateful for the many friends and members I have met and gotten to know. I am grateful for the students who studied with me, teaching me as I taught them. I am grateful for all the people that have worked by my side to help make Temple Sholom what it is. I am grateful that you have allowed me to be by your side, at the happiest of times, and at the saddest of times. It has been a privilege to serve as your rabbi.

As a community, we also have a great deal to be thankful for. Temple Sholom is filled with loving and caring people who welcome the stranger, reach out to others in need, find meaning in worship and study, volunteer their time and their love, and have worked together for over sixty years to make Temple Sholom what it is. There are so many special people who have made Temple Sholom their home. Cherish your synagogue. Continue to be thankful for what you have, and may you go from strength to strength.

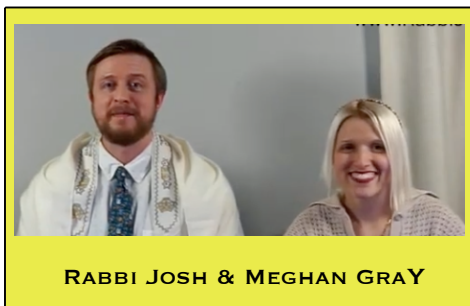

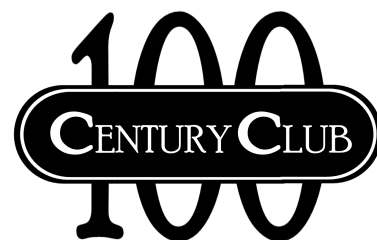


## *For the High Holy Days*

At **Hadassah Medical Organization**, a diverse community of healthcare professionals work side by side to deliver superlative patient care, and to carry out medical research that impacts people in every corner of the globe. **HMO** receives severely ill or injured patients whom other hospitals turn away because they lack the expertise to heal them.

Hadassah has two remarkable hospitals—Hadassah Mount Scopus, a community hospital built in 1939, and Hadassah Ein Kerem, a tertiary care facility built in 1961. Hadassah Ein Kerem is home to the Charlotte R. Bloomberg Mother & Child Center and the new state-of-the-art inpatient facility, the Sarah Wetsman Davidson Hospital Tower, which was dedicated in 2012. The Hadassah-Hebrew University School of Medicine is also located in Jerusalem.

In 1962, renowned artist Marc Chagall selected the Abell Synagogue at Hadassah's hospital in Ein Kerem as the site of his twelve iconic stained glass windows, representing the twelve tribes of Israel. At the installation of the breathtaking works of art, the artist said, "This is my modest gift to the Jewish people, who have always dreamt of biblical love, friendship and of peace among all people."

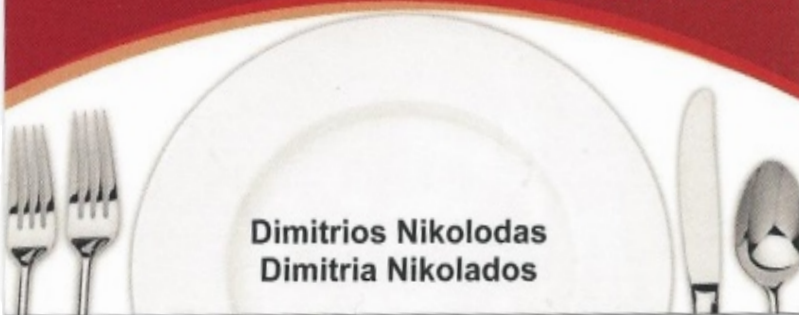
