Planning for Purim

Where are our children?



Children are scarce at the temple these days. Why is this? One reason is that we did not have many children, so we don't have many grandchildren. Most of the grandchildren that we do have moved away from the Catskills and are now located all over the United States and the world. We don't have to think hard to identify grandchildren located in the UK, Australia, California, and Texas. Furthermore, most of our grandchildren did not marry or married non-Jewish partners. The younger they are, the more likely they are to declare that they have no religion (Pew Research Center 2020). In 2020, 41% percent of Jews under the age of 30 did not affiliate with a synagogue compared to 22% of Jews over 65.

This is not to say that the number of Jews in the world is declining. The ultraorthodox have more than made up for our deficiency in children. An estimated one in seven Jews in the world today is ultraorthodox. The average Haredi (ultraorthodox) woman has six to seven children compared to 1.6 per woman in Europe, 1.8 in the United States and 3 in Israel. Orthodox Jewish adults have 3.3 children on average, while non-Orthodox Jews have an average of 1.4 children. It will come as no surprise to us here in the Catskills to learn that, if current birthrates continue, nearly one out of every four Jews in the world is projected to be [Haredi](#) by 2040. And 60 to 70 percent will remain observant. In Israel today 17 percent of the Jewish population is Haredi, and in the United States 12 percent of the Jewish population, about 700,000 people, is Haredi.



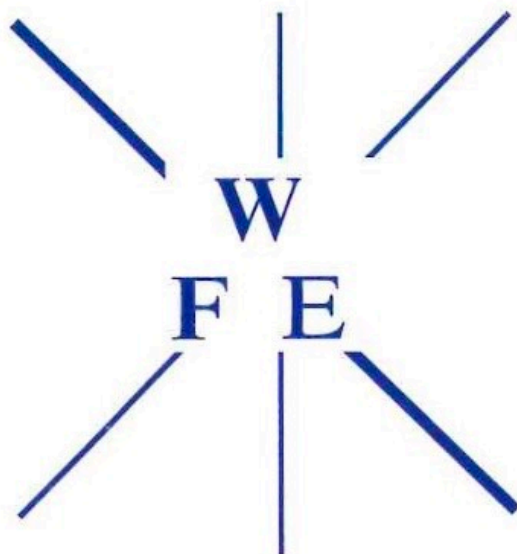
