Change Comes to the Mountains

The Catskills are different from when I first started to come up here in 1988. I am also different. Then, we were living busy lives in Teaneck, NJ, with four children and jobs in the City. We just wanted a quiet place to relax on weekends.

We first saw this place in winter, in the snow. It was kind of scary. A babbling old man sat in a rocker on the front porch of an old trailer. The lawn was decorated with bedsprings and a defunct water heater. Remains of an old car sat at the bottom of a hill. A side building was half finished.



The trailer was on 17 acres three quarters of a mile in from a secondary road, and the asking price was \$70,000. Coming from Teaneck, that seemed like the bargain of the year! We grabbed it. We later learned that we had considerably overpaid.

When spring came, we discovered that our 17 acres included a pond. We also found that the isolated road served as a dump as well as a party spot for locals. That old trailer served as our weekend retreat for 12 years. It suffered from vandalism and dumping, as well as wear and tear, but that didn't bother us much. It was quiet.



After my divorce in 2000, I decided to build a real house up here. Dave joined me and we moved into the house in 2009. My daughter and her husband built a house and a farm next door.

Meanwhile, the Catskills had changed.

There were traffic jams in Rock Hill. Hassidic communities had sprung up from Mountain Dale to Livingston Manor. Monticello was bustling, with crowds of Hassidim and many Jewish stores. Marshalls and Old Navy opened branches in Thompson Square Mall. Medical centers opened in Rock Hill and Monticello.

It suits me. I appreciate the convenience of nearby shopping. I like the Shabbat and holiday atmosphere. The traffic doesn't bother me because I'm sitting under an umbrella, enjoying my quiet place.

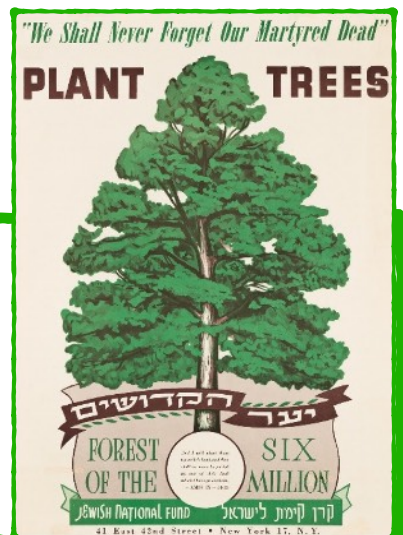

He lectures and presents at numerous conferences and seminars each year, and his areas of special interest include heritage tourism, Colonial America, the U.S. Constitution, the early settlement of the Upper Delaware region, and the evolution of Sullivan County's resort industry, including the so-called Borscht Belt.

Rabbi Molly Karp to Lead High Holiday Services

We are fortunate this year to have Rabbi Molly Karp leading our High Holiday services. Rabbi Karp has strong credentials as a Jewish educator. She was ordained by the Academy for Jewish Religion in Yonkers, New York, which has a pluralistic approach to Jewish learning. The Academy teaches across the various Jewish approaches, from Orthodox to Reform.



A multitalented individual, Rabbi Karp sings and accompanies herself on guitar. For the High Holidays, she will conduct services using our High Holiday prayerbooks. She will not be using slides.

Rabbi Karp has a longstanding interest in Jewish education, having earned a Masters degree in Religious Education from Hebrew Union College – Jewish Institute of Religion, in 1982. She also spent 10 years studying Bible and Ancient Semitic languages at the Jewish Theological Seminary. Since 2016, Rabbi Karp has conducted online courses as the creator of S.A.J.E., her Senior Adult Jewish Education school. Her erudition will be in evidence during her sermons. So, the Holidays will be a learning experience as well as a time to contemplate.

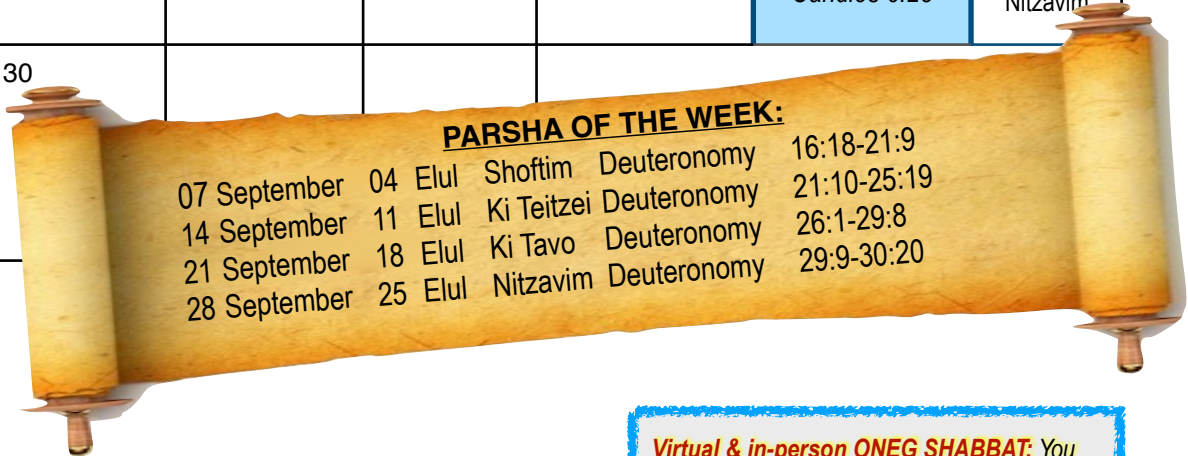

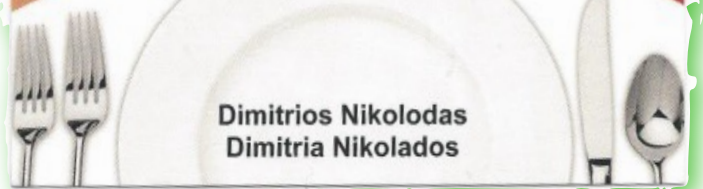
