## CHANUKAH CANDLE LIGHTING

One candle is added to the **hanukkiyah** (9-branch menorah) each night. The first night, you light the **shamash** (the one at a different height) and one Hanukkah candle. By the eighth night, you light all of the candles.

Candles are added to the **hanukkiyah** from right to left (like Hebrew writing).

Add the number of candles corresponding to the night of Hanukkah.

Light the **shamash** and hold it while reciting the blessings.

**Do not light the other candles until the blessings are done!**

**Then use the shamash to light from left to right with the newest candle lit first.**
