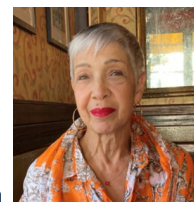

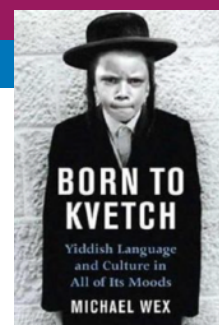

## From OUR NEW President...



As it turns out, Temple Sholom and I were born the same year, 1954. A very auspicious year indeed.

The first formal services of Temple Sholom were held at the Crawford Memorial Library on February 12, 1954, and affiliation with the Union of American Hebrew Congregations and our charter was established in June of that same year. Through the Herculean efforts of the dedicated members of that time, our building became a reality in September 1963.

Although my family belonged to a different synagogue, many of my friends' families were members of Temple Sholom. I remember attending my friends' bar and bat mitzvahs when we were all adolescents. I always found the services warm and welcoming.

After I moved back east to raise my family, we joined the temple and my son enrolled in Hebrew school. Shortly after my son's bar mitzvah 20 years ago, I joined the board of trustees and have served ever since.

When I reflect on the temple's 70 year history, I can't help but think about the giants who have served as president before me. Each and every one dedicated themselves to the temple and were deeply committed to the needs of the congregation. I realize I have big shoes to fill.

Shrinking congregations are the norm these days, and we are no different. Our numbers are small, but our love for Temple Sholom is huge. I believe every one of us has a deep connection to the temple, and it would be hard to imagine life without it. Our focus these days is how can we continue to not just survive, but even thrive? The board continues to explore creative ways to raise money and reduce costs so that we can ensure another 70 years for the temple.

Despite the financial and membership challenges, as newly elected president of the congregation, I can't help but feel optimistic for the future.
