When the patriarch Jacob saw his beloved son Joseph after being apart for 20 years, Jacob recited the first use of the shema: Shema Yisroel, Adonai Elohainu, Adonai Echad.

When the father of freed hostage Yosef Chaim Ohana saw his son for the first time after 2 years, he recited the same holy text.

These words are not simply echos from our ancient scrolls. These are real, living words that show us how relevant Judaism still is. These words show us holding and releasing our collective breath for the entire 2 years of this crisis. These words prove that we never forgot those who were waiting for us for rescue, for saving, and for returning to their final resting place.

How often have we said "now, more than ever, we need to stand together" over the last 2 years? Has it become less true?

With the staggering amount of antisemitism, can we afford any schisms in our midst? Should we take the time to point out how different we all are from each other and how that keeps us separate? What has this gotten us?

Friends, I have no answers. I only have these questions. What else is there to do? What can I do? How do we stand together? Donate to the IDF? Say Shabbat Shalom to another Jew on Friday? Thank the local establishments for their patience in the summer while insisting "we're not all like that"?

There are no answers. As the last 2 years have shown us, we do not run the show. Perhaps the best we can hope for is to make our small corner of the world more kind-hearted so that the next person will want to, as well.






